## WHAT IS THE

## SOCIAL BENEFIT?

- artistic and creative stimulation.
- prompting creative thought leads to great ideas.
- helps analytical thinkers --> creative thinking.
- formal creative process --> practice makes perfect.
- great ideas --> great rewards.
- multi-purpose and durable:
- children can play and learn with them too.
- age-, gender-, location- neutral.
- pass on as antiques from this generation to the next.
- throw them. build with them. use as magic 8-ball.
- stress relief.
- it may be a fun toy, but it's actually useful.
- if they make me happy, they're likely to make others happy too, and that's a good thing.



## WHAT IS THE ECONOMIC BENEFIT?

- great design ideas are often economically beneficial for all parties (and the future).
- win-win: designer is successful, client is successful.
- product is easy to produce = cheap to produce, more profit.
- easily accessible materials = worldwide availability.
- sustainable materials = long term viability.
- minimal assembly = cheap/clean manufacturing.
- easy to substitute materials and/or production methods and still produce the same product.
- square shapes = no waste of materials or transport.
- many spin-offs and expansion packs can be produced.
- possible to DIY = free to DIY, possible to customize.
- if children can learn to be creative also, then that's an investment in our future.


## WHAT IS THE ENVIRONMENTAL BENEFIT?

- wood from sustainable sources is sustainable.
- whole wood blocks = no off-gassing, recyclable.
- minimal fabrication $=$ not harmful to manufacturers or environment.
- minimal packaging:
- chipboard
- chipboard is paper-pulp based, not plastic.
- biodegradable
- duralar
- duralar decomposes faster than acetate.
- very thin, 0.004 " thickness.
- square shapes $=$ no waste of materials or transport.
- multi-purpose and re-usable in a number of ways.
